**Luke 9:28-36-2nd Sunday of Lent
"Prayer"**

The Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord gives us a radiant image of the transfigured Jesus. It is no small coincidence that this event occurs when Peter, John and James follow Jesus to a mountaintop to pray. While He is in deep prayer, Jesus is revealed as God's Son, His "chosen one." Luke tells us that while Jesus was praying "his face changed appearance and his clothes became dazzling white" 9v29). Prayers transfigures. Prayer transforms. On this feast we are reminded of the power of prayer. In his Summa ST. Thomas Aquinas teaches that prayer merits graces from God and brings a certain spiritual refreshment of the mind (82.2). The more we gaze on the face of Christ in prayer, the more we are transfigured by his presence. Today, let us renew our resolve to persevere in prayer so that we may be transformed into God's radiant image and likeness each day.
