**FROM THE PASTOR**

**Luke 6:27-38 – 7<sup>th</sup> Sunday Ordinary Time  
“Love your Enemies”**

In today's Gospel Jesus says, "Forgive and you will be forgiven" (v37). We should pay close attention to these words because of all people, Jesus practices what He preaches. Our receiving forgiveness (or mercy) is conditional upon how much forgiveness we show others. The way we respond to others is the way God will respond to us. God's mercy is always there for us (Mt. 18;21), but is our mercy always there for others? We will be shown mercy to the extent that we give mercy, and no more. We repeat this principle every time we say the Our Father as we ask: "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." However, many times we are asked to forgive, we must forgive. Why? Simply because Jesus said so!

The year of St. Joseph has ended, but we would like to honor him on his Feast Day on **Saturday March 19, 2022**. Fr. Piotr will celebrate Mass and we will recite the Litany of St. Joseph together.
