**FROM THE PASTOR**

**Luke 6:39-45 -8<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**  
**"Mortal and Venial Sin "**

In Today's Gospel Jesus asks how we could point out a minor defect (a splinter) in the eye of another, while we fail to see the serious flaw (a beam) in our own eye. The splinter and beam represent the two kinds of sin, mortal, and venial. Sin is a turning away from God by destroying the life of grace in the soul. For a sin to be mortal, three conditions must exist: (1) the act is gravely wrong, and the act is committed with (2) full knowledge and (3) deliberate consent (CCC 1857). If we die in a state of mortal sin eternal separation from God is our eternal destiny (Mt 25:41f). Venial sin weakens our relationship with God but does not destroy the of grace in the soul. A sin is venial if any of the three conditions for mortal sin do not exist, i.e., the act is a less serious matter, and/or the sinner acted without sufficient knowledge or freedom of will.
