**John 21:1 – 9 - 3rd Sunday of Easter  
“The Primacy of Peter**

In today’s Gospel Jesus confers upon Peter the primacy promised him as the rock on which Christ would build His Church (Mt 16:18). It is a primacy of jurisdiction which means possession of supreme teaching and legislative powers in the Church That was given to the Bishops of Rome, of which Peter was the first. After His resurrection Jesus gave this primacy to Peter when He said to Peter, “Feed my lambs...Tend my sheep...Feed my sheep” (v15-17). With these words Jesus entrusted his Flock, His universal Church to Peter and his successors. The shepherding role conferred on Peter was that of ruling and guiding the Church, just as Jesus had served as the “Good Shepherd” while on earth.
