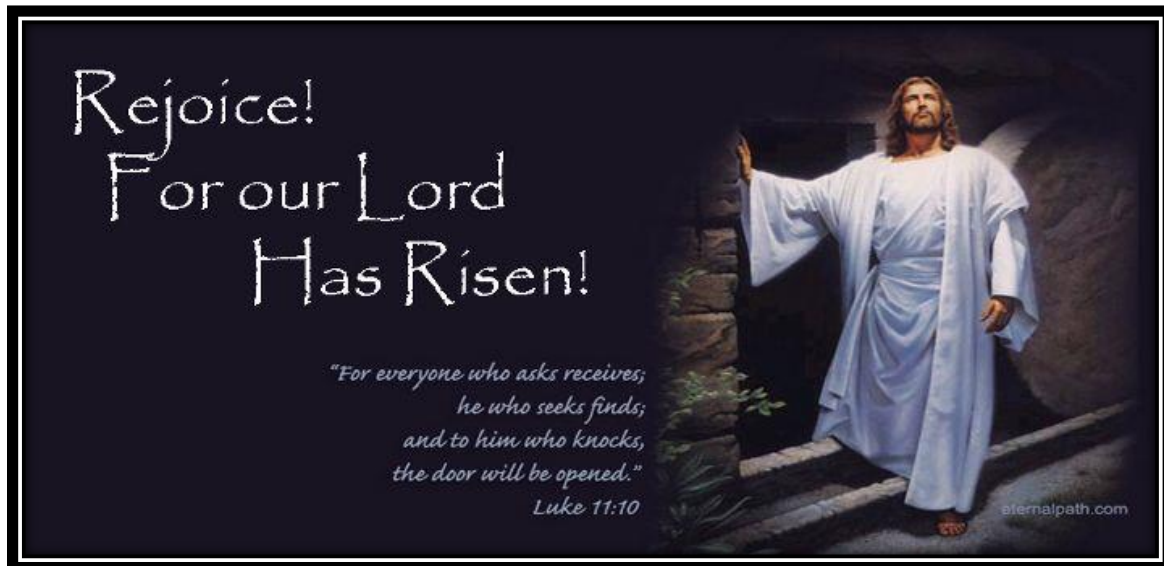

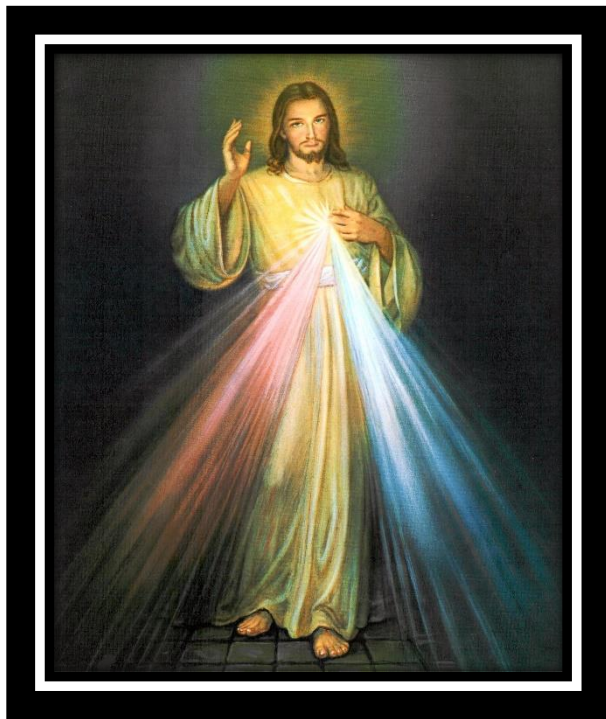

The Divine Mercy image of Jesus is not another ordinary holy picture of Jesus. It is an image of Jesus himself revealed to St.

Faustina and commanded her to have it painted. Jesus promised many graces to those who venerate this image and wanted it made known throughout the whole world.

St. Faustina said "The two rays denote Blood and Water...

The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous...

The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls...

These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by the lance of the Cross. (Diary Note 77)

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

We celebrate Easter, the greatest feast of the Christian year! From His death on Good Friday, Christ has risen to new life, and His Resurrection gives us the hope of eternal life. In Eastern Catholic and Eastern Orthodox churches today. Christians greet each other with cries of "**Christ is Risen!**" and respond "**Indeed He is Risen!**" Over and over, we sing a hymn of Celebration.

Christ, the Lord is risen today, Alleluia!
All triumphant holy day, Alleluia!
Who did once upon the cross, Alleluia!
Suffer to redeem our loss, Alleluia!

In Western Catholic churches, the Alleluia is sung for the first time since the beginning of Lent. Our fast is over; now is the time for celebration. We began singing hymns of joy at the Easter Vigil; and we should continue that joy as we enjoy our Easter meal and throughout the year.

Throughout it all, however we should always keep in mind that Easter isn't just some spiritual event that happened just once, long ago; we don't say that "Christ was risen" but "**Christ is Risen,**" because **He rose, body and soul,** and is still alive and present with us today. That is the true meaning of Easter.

As we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ together with our Parish Staff, we wish all of you **Happy and Blessed Easter.** May you always remember that with Christ anything and everything is possible.
