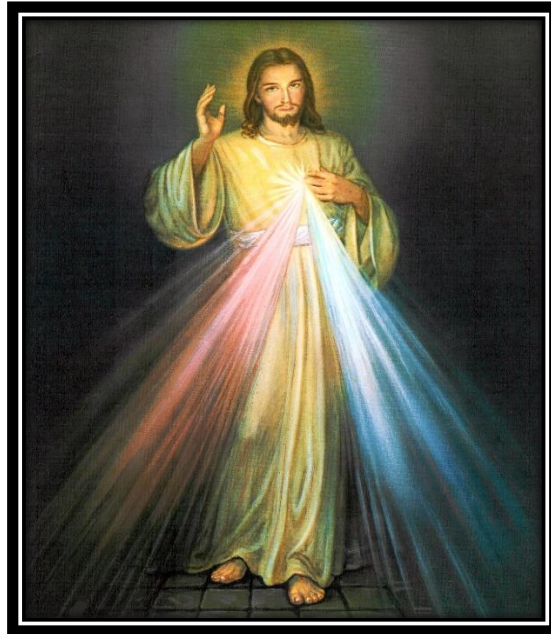

**Divine Mercy Sunday (2nd Sunday of Easter)
"Chaplet of Divine Mercy"**

In 1953 Our Lord appeared to St. Faustina Kowalska, a member of the Congregation of Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. During these apparitions Jesus taught St. Faustina the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, a prayer that is said using ordinary rosary beads. Start by saying an Our Father, Hail Mary, and an Apostles Creed. Then on the Our Father beads say: Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world." On the Hail Mary beads say: "For the sake of His sorrowful passion have mercy on us and on the whole world." End by repeating three times: "Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world." Our Lord asked St. Faustina to recite this chaplet unceasingly promising: "Oh, what great graces I will grant to souls who will recite this chaplet...Even the most hardened sinner, if he recites this chaplet even once. Will receive great grace from My infinite mercy..."
