**Luke 4:1-13 – 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Lent**  
**“Temptation”**

A temptation is anything that inclines a person to commit sin, that's what makes temptation so dangerous, it can lead to alienation from God. Some temptations arise from within ourselves, (Jam 1:14f), from our passions and emotions, while we experience other temptations from the world. Persons, places, and things can be occasions of sin to us, as they were to Jesus in today's Gospel. Temptations and struggles are part of life, even Jesus faced them. We should not expect a carefree life just because we have faith in Jesus but because of our faith God will be there for us at our most difficult times if only we ask. Remember, "God is faithful and will not let you be tried beyond your strength; (1 Cor 10:12)
